- Student must have at least 25 semester hours remaining at the end of the summer, 2018.

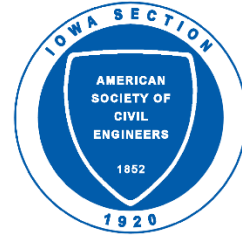
In addition, applicants will be judged by the following criteria:
