In addition, applicants will be judged by the following criteria:

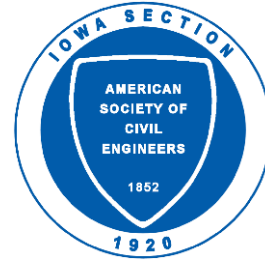
- ◆ Career path, goals and level of involvement with ASCE.
